

Internet Usage and Cloud

540 Gigabytes per day is the average amount of data used.

(If your data plan was 5gb per month on your phone we would exceed your monthly allotment by over 100 times in a single day)


The server passed 588.6 gigabytes and 5261583 sessions.

Shift to the Cloud

In 2008 we were around 25% cloud based and 75% local device based.

In 2014 we were around 50% cloud based and 50% local device based

In 2017 we are around 75% cloud based and 25% local device based.

Teaching resources, Staff documents, Student documents, etc have all continued to shift towards cloud based solutions.



Devices

We average around 2800-3100 devices connected to our Internet connection at anytime during a school day.

This includes smartphones, tablets, laptops, desktops you name it.

The majority of High School Students have smart phones.

The majority of Teachers have smart phones.

Devices | iMac and iPads

iMacs are aging and iPads are aging.

They have held up well and some are in service from 2007.

With the influx of Chromebooks replacements of iPads and iMacs will be limited. They are simply not needed in same numbers / same lab configurations.

There are still 170 student iMacs in service as of 2017.

Moving Forward

Out network WAN speed now operates at 1000mbps (1gbps).

In 2008 Our WAN speed was 100mbps

In 2015 Our WAN speed was 200mbps

Our connection exceeds our state's recommendation through the 2021 school year.







- Check Grades
