Why do Learning Walks?

- Increase teachers' toolbox of instructional/ managerial strategies.
- Highlight effective teaching practices at our schools.
- Improve the culture/climate of our buildings.

When do Learning Walks Take Place?

- Three times per year ½ day each
 - October
 - February
 - April
- Spend approximately 5-7 minutes in each classroom.

Who Participates?

- All licensed-staff will participate in one walk.
- Building principal is a team member in each group.
- BLT members spread themselves out among teams.

Benefits


- Opportunity to apply effective teaching practices.
