Motion by Puentes, seconded by Snodgrass to approve recommendation to accept the Property Casualty and Liability/Workers Compensation bid package from the Prairie State Insurance Cooperative, effective July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015, in the amount of \$251,221.00. This bid specifies a three-year commitment to Prairie State.

Cheri Hosteng, Bullis Sundberg, our incumbent agent, addressed the Board. Ms. Hosteng explained the bid process, noting the differences between coverages submitted by WCSIT-ISDA and Prairie State Insurance.

Mr. Puentes expressed concern with a three-year contract with Prairie State that does not lock in a rate.

Mrs. Coleman is concerned with Prairie State's inflexibility in bidding the packages, ie. equipment coverage and Board liability limits are not comparable to what we have had with WCSIT-ISDA.

Mrs. Mickley promoted a vote for the local agent who contributes revenues to the District and 14 children attend D228 schools.
