  - Hear First Reading of Ballot Proposition for April 2015 Construction Referendum—this will come before the Board for approval in January. Between the Health/Life Safety Bonds (≅\$9,000,000), Alternate Revenue Bonds (≅\$11,000,000), and April 2015 Construction Referendum, ProjectLEAF will not exceed \$36,000,000.
- b. GOAL: Hear First Reading of Board Policy 2:245—Program Evaluation Philosophy
- c. Hear First Reading of Board Policies 4:170, 5:280, and 7:180 per compliance with ROE Audit
- d. Review Joint Annual Conference

Board members shared their highlights of the 2014 JAC. Presentation by D228 Team Leaders/Administrators: "Changing Times Means It's Time for Change; Teaming for Improved Leadership" was well received. All members enjoyed the speakers, particularly John Draper.

- 6. CSBO Report, including Action Items
  - a. Reviewed draft of tentative FY16 Budget with Levy Request
  - b. Consider/Approve 2014 Property Tax Levy

Motion by Puentes, seconded by VanDeWoestyne to approve the 2014 Property Tax Levy as presented reflecting 4.1950 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. A Truth In Taxation Hearing is not required. The total amount of the December 2014 levy, including bond and interest, is \$14,011,201.00, a 4.8968% increase.

- 7. Superintendent Report, including Action Items
  - a. Consider/Approve Resolution
    - transferring funds from the school facility occupation tax fund of the Geneseo Community Unit School District #228, Henry and Whiteside Counties, Illinois, to the bond and interest fund of said School District, and,
    - ii. abating a portion of the taxes heretofore levied to pay debt service on the General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2009, of said School District

b. Review School Calendar Feedback Survey for 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18

The survey opinions, to date, closely reflect calendars previously used in prior years and as has been proposed for 2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18 school years. The survey will remain open until December 19. Final results of the survey will be shared and final calendars for 2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18 will be presented to the Board for approval in January.

c. Consider/Approve 2015 Health Insurance Plan Year Program

In light of the current health insurance fund balances, Mr. Kuffel recommends a 2.5% rate <u>decrease</u> proposal for <u>Active Employees</u> and <u>no change</u> in rates for <u>Retirees</u>.

i. Motion by Mickley, seconded by Puentes to approve 2015 Insurance Plan Year Program, decreasing rates for active employees by 2.5% and no change in rates for retirees

Motion carried by roll call vote of six ayes, (DeBrock, Snodgrass, VanDeWoestyne, Ford, Puentes, Mickley), one absent (Coleman).

- d. Consider/Approve Vision 20/20 Resolution
  - i. Motion by Mickley, seconded by Snodgrass to approve Vision 20/20 Resolution
