

Structure

The Quad City Career and Technical Education (CTE) Consortium (QCC TEC) is formed by a joint agreement by sixteen member school districts with high schools located in Rock Island, Henry, Mercer and Stark Counties in Illinois.

Formed in 2007, by the merger of the Quad-City VoTech Region, EFE 210, and Tri-County VoTech Region, EFE 180, the Quad City CTE Consortium is governed by a Board of Control. This Board of Control is comprised of the Superintendent from each of the member school districts. Under the authority of the Board of Control, United Township High School District #30 acts as the administrative, legal, and fiscal agent for the Quad City CTE Consortium.

The programs and activities of the Quad City CTE Consortium are under the direction of the System Director, who is employed by the administrative agent. The System Director reports to the Board of Control and the administrative agent's Board of Education.


