<u>Context</u>: The Board of Education recently adopted a new vision statement, included in Board Policy 1:30 of "**Teach**, Learn, Care". This vision statement becomes operationalized to some extent, through the thoughtful application of core values such as "providing a safe and caring environment, holding high expectations for achievement, responsibly stewarding district finances, and communicating effectively."

Back in June of 2011, the Board of Education amended Board Policy 1:35-1 related to Academic Targets and it is time to review these again. Part of the reason for this change is that we no longer administer the DRA2 Reading Assessment, and we have added the Discovery Education benchmark assessments. We also recognize that there will be a shift soon to the PARCC tests and new measures of Common Core Standards mastery of English/Language Arts and Math curriculum in the very near future.

<u>Proposal</u>: In an effort to provide a venue for community input and a collaborative effort with the Board of Education, administration, faculty, parents and student involvement—we will be conducting 3 meetings to prepare a recommendation to be presented to the Board of Education for consideration at the April 10, 2014 meeting, with a final vote anticipated at the May, 2014 Board meeting.
