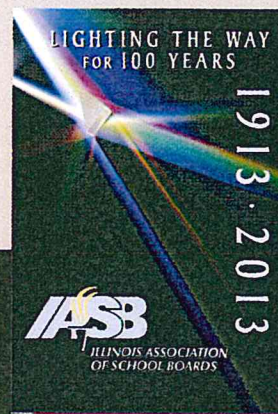
This course satisfies the requirements for mandatory board member training per Public Act 097-0008 including instruction in:
