During the month of January we had five students earn their placement back to their home school. We have staffed in four new students to the program this month. The total enrollment at the end of January is eleven students with three in the high school and eight in the middle school.

This month our educational tour took us to the clock tower building on Arsenal Island. The students were presented the history of the building and then climb to the top to view the bald eagles over the Mississippi River.

We had eight students serve twenty in school suspensions during the month. There were only two out of school, suspensions in the month of January, which is lower than last school year. This month the students will be working on Romeo and Juliet, Western settlement, inventors of Illinois, along with a Black History month project which will include a trip to the Geneseo Museum to learn about the Underground Railroad.
