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How It Will Look At GHS

• Who?

- Seniors will have the opportunity to take a full year elective course entitled "Introduction to Education and Teaching" for the 2023-24 school year.
- Students will get <u>3 days of instruction and 2 days of field experience each week</u> at one of our schools in the district.

• What?

• The role of students will be to visit and observe classrooms in our district and apply knowledge they have learned in their course in those classrooms.

• How?

• Curriculum: The course will follow a detailed developed curriculum entitled <u>"Educators Rising"</u>

Note: **This is different from past experiences of students coming over.**

How It Will Look At Our Elementary Schools

• Schedule

- GHS students will attend 2 class periods/week
- Role of Mentor Teacher
 - Provide a learning environment that welcomes and inspires!
 - Provide opportunities for students to engage in educational experiences

Educator/Student Placements

- In order to maximize student learning experiences, schedules will be created that may allow for rotations among students and classrooms.
- \circ \quad This allows for more teachers to be hosts.
- Schedules will be communicated to interested host teachers in advance, once enrollment is finalized.

Support

- On-site instructor visits conducted by GHS classroom instructor.
- On-site coaching opportunities for student with Mrs. Boone. (i.e. theory to practice discussions & debriefs).
- Reflection
 - Feedback and reflection check-ins to monitor needs, ideas for improvement and provide support.
