- <u>Illinois School Report Cards</u> were released October 30. This year, <u>three of our schools</u> were rated <u>Exemplary</u>, which means they are among the top 10% of schools in the state! Our other two schools were rated close behind at the high end of Commendable. This is a testament to the hard work of our staff who have built systems for success. Way to go, Geneseo!
