LEA Designated Person for Asbestos

A Local Education Agency (LEA) must have a designated person for asbestos with that title and responsibility. The duties include assurances that the LEA is in compliance with the laws that apply to Schools.

The LEA Designated person must have adequate training. The training shall include:

- 1) health effects of asbestos
- 2) detection, identification and assessment of ACBM
- 3) options for controlling ACBM
- 4) asbestos management programs
- 5) relevant Federal and State regulations.

I recommend Randy Bormann, District Maintenance Director, continue to serve as the LEA Designated Person for the Geneseo School District. Randy has completed the 40-hour Asbestos Supervisor Initial Training. The course covers all of the areas required and more.
