Topics of discussion:

The meeting opened at 10:40 a.m.

The policy committee reviewed the Illinois Association of School Boards' recommendations for updates from PRESS Plus Issue 121, which includes the following policies:

The updates for policies 2:200 and 2:220 come with required questions, and for all three questions asked, the committee recommends responding with “no,” which is the default.

The committee recommends that all changes are accepted as presented by the IASB.

The committee also reviewed 2:140-E Exhibit (Guidance for Board Member Communications, Including Email Use), which exists in conjunction with the Open Meetings Act. The document reinforces that the Board of Education discusses “District business only at a properly noticed Board meeting. Other than during a Board meeting, a majority or more of a Board quorum may not engage in contemporaneous interactive communication, whether in person or electronically, to discuss District business.”

A first reading PRESS Board Policy Review for Issue 121 will take place at the Board of Education’s regular meeting on May 14, 2026 with a second reading at the June 11, 2026 meeting. The deadline for submitting PRESS Plus Issue 121 is July 26, 2026.
