Topics of Discussion

The meeting opened at 1:01 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to review current policies and procedures related to behavior and discipline. More specifically, the committee reviewed various policies and procedures regarding misconduct and discipline for students with disabilities, general student behavior, and bullying, intimidation, and harassment.

Committee members reviewed what is currently being done to support staff, including providing de-escalation training for all staff during the opening Institute Day and Trauma-Informed Practices this spring. The committee discussed various policies and procedures at the elementary, middle, and high school levels, including restorative approaches to discipline, restraint/timeout definitions and procedures.

The committee shared data regarding bullying incidents in our district last year and this year, noting there are very few incidents in Geneseo, and discussed committing to collecting and entering data in consistent fashion throughout our buildings with the eventual goal of having data visualizations to help us analyze our needs.

It highlights relevant language from board policies, parent handbooks, and a form to report incidents.

Members concluded the meeting with a conversation regarding classroom behaviors – including dysregulation and how we are supporting our staff – and discussed the need to look at Tier 1 practices.

The committee plans to meet twice per year, with the next meeting taking place in the fall of 2026.
