The committee recommends that all changes are accepted as presented by the IASB.

In addition, for policy 5:140, Solicitations By or From Staff, the committee recommends modifying the last sentence from "...prior approval from the Superintendent" to "...prior approval from the Superintendent or designee."

The committee also reviewed policy 8:25, Advertising and Distributing Materials in Schools Provided by Non-School Related Entities. There are no changes recommended at this time, but Superintendent Delgado wanted to ensure the board is familiar with the policy and rationale behind it.

A first reading PRESS Board Policy Review for Issue 122 will take place at the Board of Education's regular meeting on August 13, 2026 with a second reading at the September 10, 2026 meeting. It is recommended that all board members review the proposed policy changes and initiate discussion on the policies for which they have questions, concerns, and/or suggestions.

The deadline for submitting PRESS Plus Issue 122 is October 28, 2026.
