

Table 1. Number of Schools by Designation and Grade Band



Table 2. Percentage of Schools by Designation and Grade Band




Note: The Comprehensive designation contains three types of schools: (1) those in the lowest performing 5 percent, (2) any high school that fails to graduate at least 2/3rds of their students, and beginning in 2023, (3) a school that completes a full Targeted school improvement cycle and remains Targeted for one or more of the same student groups for which it was originally designated. The Intensive designation is those schools that complete a full Comprehensive school improvement cycle but remain in the lowest performing 5 percent. Thus, the size of the Comprehensive designation category may be higher or lower than 5 percent.






ELA Proficiency on the IAR

Science Proficiency on the ISA


