✓ Updates

- **Enrollment** numbers are in. As of August 20, our K-12 enrollment was 2,304. This number is down 93 students from this time last year, which is the largest 1-year drop in recent years. Our Kindergarten numbers are low (150), which is an indication of future groups of incoming students.
- **Health Life Safety** Building Walkthroughs took place this week. Our facilities are in great shape and we received positive feedback about the condition of our buildings. We are so proud of our teams that work to make sure things are in excellent shape!
- The **Board Policy Committee** met on September 3 to go through PRESS policy updates. These will be presented as a first reading at our Board meeting.
- ISBE has made some updates to state **Proficiency Benchmarks** for testing platforms (IAR, ISA, and ACT). These updates will help us better project career and college readiness as aligned with national standards. These new cut scores will be applied to testing from Spring 2025 and reports will be available in the near future.
