Updates from around the district and the state.

- Thursday, May 9 will mark our 158th day of student attendance and leaves just 17 school days left in the school year. Just a reminder that Tuesday, June 4 is an 11:30 dismissal. The first day of student attendance for the <u>2024-25 school year</u> is scheduled for Wednesday, August 14.

In the fall, U.S. News ranked GHS as 96th among Illinois schools and 2,717th nationally. Regionally, GHS continues to rank second, trailing only Pleasant Valley High School in Bettendorf.
