Superintendent Report 8/2/24

Updates from around the district and the state.

- 1. Wednesday, August 14 marks the first day of student attendance. We've had a lot of new-to-the-district students register this year. I will have final enrollment numbers for you by Monday, August 19.
- 2. Our Leadership Teams did an excellent job of filling many open certified positions this year so we can be fully staffed on the first day of school. Most of them have already been <u>introduced on our website</u>, <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Instagram</u>, and warmly welcomed by the community. A complete list of certified additions is below for your convenience.
- 3. The middle school and high school summer projects are finished and look great. Our maintenance and custodial staff across the district did an excellent job getting each of our buildings ready for the first day of classes and even got our teachers back in their classrooms as early as possible. A brief summary of some of the projects and some photos are attached to my report.
- 4. I recently attended a meeting hosted by a company called <u>APEX</u> that plans to build up to 75 new windmills in Henry County, a majority of which would fall within our district's boundaries. This could generate additional tax revenue through an increased EAV.
- 5. Kudos to the teachers, students, and everyone else involved in the expanded summer school program this year. This program has helped our students recover unfinished learning and given them a boost into the coming school year!
- 6. As a part of the policy committee's work on PRESS Issue #115, some discussion was had regarding Policy 4:70 and whether the district should have an energy audit performed, looking specifically at solar energy options at GMS and GHS. There are preferred vendors who partner with IASB, IASA, and IASBO that work specifically with school districts, know the red tape that exists, and help get boards viable options to consider. More information will be shared once we know the particulars.
