Our school nurse crew has successfully made it through another school year. Through their dedicated efforts Geneseo Dist #228 students were in good hands during their time in our schools.

We still continue to see an increase in medical needs across our grade levels with the level of acuity ranging from mild to severe. Every year these needs change and we adapt to meet these students' needs while they're here. This can make leaving our buildings or being without a substitute nurse difficult at times. I appreciate, very much, the flexibility of this group to cover as best as we can.

I have spent a good amount of time this year learning and familiarizing myself with Medicaid & medical reimbursements we are eligible for. When things are fine tuned, I'd love the opportunity to report on that and how it can benefit our school district.

Our Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP) has been in place a full school year now and there has been a lot of interest from staff members in becoming CPR certified. If this is something our district could look at and help with facilitating, I think the benefit would be palpable.

I met recently with staff at Hammond Henry Hospital and our athletic department staff to go over our district's concussion protocol. It was good to have all the minds in one space to discuss issues and figure out ways to streamline and improve our processes in collaboration with Hammond Henry. During this time we discussed baseline concussion testing. I'm happy to report that we will now be including cheerleading and softball along with football and soccer that we have already been doing. I'm even more happy to report that we are initiating this at the middle school level for the appropriate sports that we offer. The baseline testing helps our nursing staff and coaches get students back on track with learning and 'playing' much more efficiently.

Deb Rokis, Helen Johnston, & Diana Wallace helped us meet the state requirements for vision and hearing. We cannot thank them enough for their continuation with helping us meet this requirement. I have been working on getting two of our nurses certified in this but due to some hiring changes at the state level, that was not able to happen this school year.
