The Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) regulation in the Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act (HHFKA) requires Districts to bring the student paid lunch price up to the target price of \$2.92. This will be a gradual increase. Below are the prices proposed for next school year to work towards that goal.
