

Superintendent Report 9/8/23

Updates from around the district and the state.

1. Thursday, September 14th marks the 21st day of student attendance. Enrollment sits at 2,456 (PK-12), which is a decrease of 16 students from last year and a decrease of 99 over the last 10 years.
2. We received the certificate of occupancy from the ROE for our new Career and Technical Education (CTE) Center on 8/30/23. Students have been busy moving equipment and tools and setting up each space. I am coordinating with Mr. Mackey to announce an Open House for the community later this month. Information forthcoming soon.
3. I am working with Sharon Neumann and the Geneseo Education Foundation to submit this year's Sherrard Foundation Grant. This year's request will go towards repurposing, remodeling, and renovating the old (existing) CTE classrooms at Geneseo High School prior to the 2024-25 school year.
