RE: Softball Spring Trip

With preconsultation with administrators, the softball program has planned a spring trip to Cocoa Beach, Florida during the break. The team would travel by bus, leaving Saturday, March 27 and departing from Florida on Thursday, April 1.

- Participation will be voluntary with no penalty for not attending.
- All fees, including transportation and lodging will be raised by the Booster Club and individuals – approximately 50% each. However, no player will be denied the opportunity because of finances.
- The Cocoa Beach training is about half of the cost of previous trips by omitting the Disney World fees, yet has a fine reputation for a quality experience.
- Softball had tried to find a closer trip this year, but was unable to find a good fit and we feared repeating the disasters of the past of spending time, travel and lodging money and not getting games in.
- The team also plans to travel with 24 players plus or minus (up from 20 +/-) and play four varsity plus four JV games as opposed to four varsity only. It is a big plus to get eight games in without missing any school.
- The team will comply with all rules and policies of the IHSA.
- A complete list of participants, itinerary, and chaperones will be presented at the March board meeting.
