	Fine Arts	Athletics	Pros/Cons
Option 1	July 19-30 2 weeks total	Week 1: July 4—11 Week 2: August 1—8 (IHSA Regulated)	<b>Pros:</b> For athletics, it is a break in the summer around the 4 <sup>th</sup> of July. It covers two weekends for travel. It breaks the summer into two parts. <b>Cons:</b> For athletics, some camps would have to be moved from corresponding dates. <b>No joint week off between athletics and fine arts.</b>
Option 2	July 19-30 2 weeks total	July 25—August 8 2 weeks total	<b>Pros:</b> It is the same time as last year. <b>There would be one joint week that both fine arts and athletics would be no contact.</b> <b>Cons:</b> For athletics, it is a long break between practices. This option would be a compromise from the Athletic Department.
Option 3	July 25—August 8 2 weeks total	July 25—August 8 2 weeks total	<b>Pros:</b> Both athletic department <b>and</b> fine arts department compromise. <b>Two full weeks of joint no contact.</b> Boy Scout Jamboree would not conflict with Band week. <b>Cons:</b> Band week is traditionally held the first week of August. It would have to be rescheduled.

Superintendent Recommendation in collaboration with Building Administration is to utilize Option 1 for the Summer of 2010.
