
Operations Update March 12, 2015





Request to Establish Parameters for Support Personnel Wages for FY 16 (approved at April Regular Board Meeting). Propose a \$50,000-\$55,000 range for wage increases, this range is roughly 2% of the aggregate ESP wage budget. The list of individual wage changes will be provided at the May Regular Board Meeting.
