- A. We will have Board members rotating in 3 groups to hear 25 minute presentations: one from the elementary schools, one from the Middle School, and one from the high school. Each set of Board members will be able to hear all three levels during the 90-minute sequence. The buildings will present Leadership Team work, School Improvement Goals, and how they plan on monitoring initiatives.
- B. I would propose the following schedule for the last phase of the evening:
- a. We spend 15-20 minutes reviewing part of our “paired conversations”—specifically some personal stories or mental models where each of you have shared a moment in the District’s history of the past five years that you see as a turning point, identity moment, key event.
  - b. We then spend 15-20 minutes reviewing the District Scorecard, Academic Targets Policy, some other key documents from this past year.
  - c. We then spend about 20 minutes focused on Board Goal Proposals for 2011-12.
  - d. We then take 15-20 minutes reviewing and improving the Board-Superintendent Governance Team relationship and understanding of procedures and responsibilities of all Team members.
  - e. We finish with a quick Plus/Delta of what we really accomplished with the day and what we have yet to accomplish.
