WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "*Board*") of Community Unit School District Number 228, Henry and Whiteside Counties, Illinois (the "*District*"), has developed a list of capital projects described in *Exhibit A* hereto (the "*Projects*"); and

WHEREAS, all or a portion of the expenditures relating to the Projects (the "*Expenditures*") (i) have been paid within the 60 days prior to the passage of this Resolution or (ii) will be paid on or after the passage of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the District reasonably expects to reimburse itself for the Expenditures with the proceeds of an obligation:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Education of Community Unit School District Number 228, Henry and Whiteside Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Intent to Reimburse. The District reasonably expects to reimburse the Expenditures with proceeds of an obligation.

Section 3. Maximum Amount. The maximum principal amount of the obligation expected to be issued for the Projects is \$2,585,000.

Section 4. Ratification. All actions of the officers, agents and employees of the District that are in conformity with the purposes and intent of this Resolution, whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 6. Repeal. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

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RECOMMENDATION TO RENOVATE MILLIKIN SOFTBALL FIELDS

Following the presentation on June 24 by Mr. Petit and Mr. Toone, I recommend to the Board of Education that approval is granted to begin renovation of the four-baseball/softball diamonds at Millikin School as presented on the diagram June 24th.

The District Architect shall approve all construction and the Director of Operations shall be directed to enforce all liability exposure precautions to minimize District risk.

The District is not expected to participate financially in the primary renovation phase of this project. The Director of Operations shall remain the primary project contact for the District and shall report to Superintendent and Board as necessary.

RECOMMENDATION: Motion to approve to renovate Millikin Ballfields for the purpose of constructing a Varsity Softball field and a Frosh-Soph Softball Field, with two additional fields available. One of the two additional fields will be sized in such a way that it could be improved in the future as a high school baseball field.
