### School Years 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18


The results of the survey work indicated that overall, people seem to find favor with the calendars as we have approved them over the past several years. Therefore, the following trends will continue:


- a. We will open the school year with 2 days of Teacher Inservice.
- b. We will not attend school on Columbus Day
- c. We will not attend school on Veterans Day
- d. We will still conduct 2 evenings of Parent Conferences
- e. We will still take all three days of school off prior to Thanksgiving.
- f. We will not attend school on Martin Luther King, Jr Day
- g. We will not attend school the week before Easter Sunday.
- h. We will conduct a full day teacher inservice on the Monday following Easter Sunday.


### A few changes in the works for the next 3 years:

- a. We will not open the year on a Monday, but rather the first inservice will be held on a Tuesday, August 11, 2015.
- b. The High School will not conduct mandatory Parent-Teacher Conferences, but will rather plan for and engage in 2 evenings of professional development. (Parents and teachers may still be able to schedule requested conferences)
- c. We will attempt to be approved for a waiver in order to convert 2, half-day inservice days into 1, full-day inservice, but it is unlikely that would go into effect until 2016-17 at the earliest.

We ask that you consider approving these 3 year calendars as presented, knowing that the Board of Education retains the right to make changes as necessary in the future.


