STATE ISSUES:

Tdap: The state is implementing a new Tdap mandate that now affects all students in 6th thru 12th grade. We communicated the new mandate to parents by way of the district web site, letters of information were sent to incoming sixth and ninth grade parents along with students in 7th, 8th, 10th, 11th & 12th grade that do not have a verified Tdap.

Update: 100% of the Geneseo students are in compliance with this mandate at the beginning of 2013 school year.

Epinephrine in Our Schools: The state is now recommending that epinephrine be on hand in the school building as an emergency back up dose. Epinephrine pens were received through a grant for each school in our district. The extra pens will be located in the nurse's office and one in the cafeteria offices.

Update: All schools have easily accessible Epi Pens in the Cafeteria and in the nurse's office

ON GOING ACTIVITY:

Computer record keeping: We continue to utilize Skyward, the school district's computer program, for data entry and record keeping. The nurses have continued to move forward with computer changes and updates so that we may use Skyward to it's fullest.

Community Involvement: This year we again worked with the physicians at UnityPoint Family Medicine and the staff at Annawan and Cambridge schools to provide a combined night for free athletic physicals. We provided 209 Athletic physicals for Geneseo students for the 2014-2015 school year.

REVIEW OF OUR GOALS FROM 2013-2014

Registration Goal: The first day exclusion policy was implemented at the start of the 2013-2014 school year. Unfortunately, there was one exclusion this year when a parent failed to adhere to a documented scheduled appointment. Even though there was the one exclusion this policy change proved to be successful and accomplished the goal that was set.

Goals for 2014-2015:

The "RN is Special Education" Online training course is now available. Our goal is to have all the full time and part time nurses in the district apply and complete the online course prior to the end of the 2016 school year. Deb Rokis and Linda DeSmith will be taking the course this summer and this fall respectively. Passing this course will allow the nurse to complete the medical review for IEP's.

On behalf of the nursing team I would like to thank the school board, administrators and district staff for the support they give us through out the year. We look forward to the challenges for the 2014-2015 school year. Have a safe and enjoyable summer.
