

Dear District Staff,

As the school year begins to wind down, it's time to start making summer plans. District 228 will again be offering our Summer Learning Adventure (SLA). For those of you who are unfamiliar with SLA, it is a program offered by the Geneseo School District for students entering grades 3 – 7. Our teachers, guest teachers, classroom aides, and other instructors have taught classes in art, history, science, drama, writing, and many other subjects to district students.

This summer we wish to offer the SLA during the week of June 13 – 17, 2011. Classes will be held at Geneseo Middle School from 8:30-10:00 and 10:15-11:45 with a 15 minute break between classes. Teachers will have a short planning period before classes start for the day. Teachers can plan on teaching the same curriculum to both classes.

Teachers will earn \$23/hour for 3.5 hours/day totaling \$402.50 for the week – mornings only. There will be a budget for supplies. The amount per class will be based on registration enrollment.

Right now, we are looking for staff members who are willing to teach a Summer Learning Adventure class. Remember this is enrichment –a chance to teach about something you love, but never had the time. Technology, fine arts, special interest in a subject area. . . the ideas are endless. Please submit a class proposal that will be published in the SLA brochure. Classes are offered based on student interest, so gear your topics for pre-teens.
