## Growth - Academics

## Take Aways

#### • For 18-19:

- OUsing eMPower and PARCC Assessment results our students have underperformed in Math grades 6-8, focus next year on instructional improvements and sequencing of units of study to improve scores
- OContinued focus on Writing across the curriculum in order to "share the load" of written literacy
