

2023 Resolutions Committee Report

The IASB Resolutions Committee met in August and reviewed nine proposals that were submitted by districts from all over the state. Details of those proposals and the committee's recommendation for each can be found in the 2023 Resolutions Committee Report. Using the Resolutions Committee Report, your board of education should discuss the proposals and determine if you agree with the Resolutions Committee's recommendations for each proposal. The proposals that received a positive recommendation, "Do Adopt," and the proposals that received a "Do Not Adopt" that have applied for appeal, will be voted on during the annual Delegate Assembly being held at the Joint Annual Conference in Chicago on November 18 at 10:30 a.m.

Each board is allowed to select one member to represent it at the Delegate Assembly to vote on behalf of the board. Once your school board has selected its representative to the Delegate Assembly, the district's roster manager can register that individual on the IASB website in the Event Calendar, IASB Delegate Assembly and Annual Business Meeting.
