
























Stand Alone vs Building Addition - Pros and Cons

- Lower Total Project Cost
- Less disruption of traffic flow
- Adequate exterior storage area hidden from view
- Safety of students to and from the building
- Stand alone building is very visible
- Potentially less change orders due to unforeseen conditions
- Allows for future addition to the Southeast corner of the high school
- More choices for exterior wall materials
- Allows for noisy instructional spaces to be away from each other
- Solvent and finishing odors contained
- Construction site easier to secure and isolate


