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IDEA Part B Flow Through, Part B Pre-School, and IDEA **Proportionate Share Cooperative Funding Options** Beginning July 1, 2019

Beginning July 1, 2019 member districts will begin receiving their Federal IDEA funds directly from ISBE. Currently all monies come to Henry-Stark Counties SED that are members of the Cooperative, and Henry-Stark applies these monies to special education programs member districts access/participate in. A new funding structure related to these changes needs to be established by the member districts in how these funds will be allocated and managed. Option 1 - LIKE IT IS NOW

• Member districts will flow all IDEA funds received back to Henry-Stark.

- IDEA funds will be applied in creating a budget for the Cooperative in the same manner as in past years.
- IDEA funds will be applied in creating the bills in the same fashion as if Henry-Stark was receiving the IDEA Funds directly.
- Billing will remain the same with a Tentative created in June for the upcoming year, and a billing adjustment made in May of that fiscal year.

Option 2

- Member districts will keep the IDEA funds and not flow the amount directly the Henry-Stark.
- IDEA funds will be utilized by the member districts to pay for special education programs provided by Henry-Stark, or within their own district.
- Billings will be created for member districts in the same manner, but will pay True Cost of programs/services from Henry-Stark accessed.
- No IDEA funds will be applied to Henry-Stark budget as offsetting cost related to billings.



Option 3

- Member districts keep all IDEA funds allocated.
- Member districts look to hire their own special education teachers, and create their own programs.
- Henry-Stark would provide Social Work, Psychology, Coordinator, some Speech Therapists, and Excel program (would look at the Life Skills programs as a possibility).

Services related to IDEA that would continue

- Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Report (June)
- Excess Cost Reporting (January)
- Guidance of IDEA Grant development, and allocating of funds appropriately.
- Working with ISBE grant coordinator related to IDEA grants.
- Proportionate Share Meetings, Services and Documentation
